## IRT Timeline

IRT applications are accepted between December 1st and March 1<sup>st</sup>
Applicants are notified of IRT's admissions decisions in May in anticipation of the new cohort starting June 1<sup>st</sup>

## Admissions & Orientation (May)

#### IRT Scholars:

- receive welcome materials from IRT
- gain access to IRT-exclusive Canvas course
- receive information about GRE prep options
- begin researching prospective graduate schools



# Summer Pre-Application Advising (June-August\*)

- receive introductory emails from IRT & Statement of Purpose Advisors
- submit assignments on Canvas, respond to surveys, participate in cohort meetings, and watch webinars
- sit for all required standardized tests
- conduct in-depth graduate school program research
- begin compiling application materials such as letters of rec, writing samples, and transcripts

\*The IRT Office is closed for the month of August

## Fall Pre-Application Advising (September-November)

- participate in weekly SOP Advising meetings and submit related Canvas assignments
- refine and finalize all graduate school application materials
- submit final School List before receiving application fee waiver instructions from IRT office
- begin uploading materials to online graduate school applications as early as October

**Note:** IRT Scholars are expected to submit **all** of their graduate school applications in full **by December 1**st!

#### Post-Application Advising (December-April)

- discuss offers of admission, invitations to interview and visit campus, and funding packages from consortium schools
- navigate graduate school communications, prepare for campus visits and interviews, and negotiate and evaluate program offers with guidance from IRT Advisor
- submit assignments on Canvas, respond to surveys, participate in cohort meetings, and watch webinars
- make a matriculation decision by April 15<sup>th</sup>
