

(ms)² Guide to Online Application

To apply to the Mathematics & Science for Minority Students program – better known as (MS)², candidates must complete the (MS)² online application, which is posted at www.andover.edu/ms2.

The (MS)² application consists of multiple sections, some that should be completed by the applicant, while others must be completed by a parent or guardian. The applicant may begin a section, logout, and then return at a later date to complete the application. Information requested includes:

- Applicant Information
- Household Information
- Affiliations
- School Information
- Recommendations
- Current Grades/Transcript
- Applicant Questions
- Parent/Guardian Questions
- Financial Information


Applicants must submit four recommendations – 8th Grade Math, 9th Grade Math, 9th Grade Science, and a 9th Grade School Counselor/Advisor (or a school official). Applicants will provide the name and email address of each of their four recommenders within the online application. Our system then will generate an automatic email that will be sent to each recommender with a link to an online recommendation form. Applicants will be able to see when their recommendations have been submitted through the Applicant Profile in their online account (by going to “Check Application Status” on our website.)

(MS)² is a scholarship program. In order for an application to be considered complete, applicants must provide information about the household income for each of their parent(s)/guardian(s).

12) Recommendations

Applicants must submit four recommendations – 8th Grade Math, 9th Grade Math, 9th Grade Science, and 9th Grade High School Advisor/School Counselor (or a school official).

Applicants will provide the name and email address of each of their four recommenders in the online application. This is entered either within the application on the Recommendations page, or on the Applicant Profile. Once entered, the system then will generate an automatic email that will be sent to each recommender with a link to an online recommendation form.

Applicants are responsible for ensuring their teachers submit their recommendation forms by the January 15 deadline. Applicants can see the status of each recommendation form (e.g., date submitted) on their Applicant Profile. Applicants can cancel a recommendation request and re-send a new email request to the same teacher or a different teacher.

If a recommendation request is being sent to a teacher, the applicant should currently be enrolled in this teacher's class. For those applicants who are on a Block Schedule and not currently enrolled in a course for which there is a required recommendation, you may still apply. Please contact us at ms2@andover.edu for guidance on whom to request a recommendation.

If an applicant does not have a guidance counselor, a request may be sent to the Head of School, principal, vice principal, or another member of the school's administration who can provide an official account of the applicant's academic performance and attendance record. A copy of the applicant's school transcript must be submitted at the same time the school official submits the guidance counselor recommendation form.

(MS)² applicants must submit four recommendations in order for their application to be complete.

- 8th Grade Math Teacher
- 9th Grade Math Teacher
- 9th Grade Science Teacher
- 9th Grade Advisor/School Counselor

The first recommendation must be from a **8th grade math** teacher. The second recommendation must be from a **9th math** teacher. The third recommendation must be from a **9th grade science** teacher. The fourth recommendation must be from the applicant's **9th grade school counselor or advisor**. If an applicant does not have a school counselor or advisor, a request may be sent to the Head of School, principal, vice principal, or another member of the school's administration who can provide an official account of the applicant's academic performance.

Recommendations are requested and received through the online application. Applicants do not need to wait until all four recommendations have been completed to submit their application. Applicants should submit their portion of the application as soon as it is complete. Our system will match the recommendations with their application.

To request a recommendation:

- Click on the "Request" button beside the type of each **required recommendation**.
- Enter the First and Last names of that **recommender** as well as their email address.
- Click the "Submit" button.

An email will automatically be sent to that recommender with a link to the online recommendation form. The recommender will complete the form and submit it on the applicant's behalf. You may check the status of each recommendation request by logging in to the online application and going to the (MS)2 Applicant Profile.


