




Mission


Founded in 1977 to advance diversity in the STEM fields by cultivating the mathematical and scientific abilities of talented under-resourced high school students of color






Program Overview

- Full Scholarship Free (incl. transportation)
- 5-week rigorous STEM program for 3-consecutive summers
- 111 scholars across three cohorts
- 6:1 student-to-faculty ratio
- 58% 1st generation college students
- 78% Household income <\$75K
- Live on 500-acre campus with 600 other students from around the world




Eligibility Criteria

- 9th grade student
- Attend a publicly funded high school (traditional, charter, or BIE tribally controlled) in current recruitment area
- Identify as Black/African American, Latine, or Native American
- Have a strong interest in STEAM


Preference is given to applicants who excel in academics (score in top 10-20% of their class) and have a demonstrated financial need (i.e., first generation and low income)



Approximately 200 students apply, of which approximately 75 are chosen as finalists to be interviewed, with **36 scholars** selected to be part of this transformative program.




